Anti-rodent Campaign 2023 (Second Phase)

The Food and Environmental Hygiene Department launches Anti-rodent Campaign every year to enhance rodent control work in the territory. The Second Phase of the Anti-rodent Campaign 2023 would be carried out from 3 July 2023 to 8 September 2023. The Anti-rodent Campaign 2023 would be carried out focusing on biotopes as follows:


1. *Markets/Market Buildings and their surroundings.*
2. *Fixed pitch hawker bazaars and their surroundings.*
3. *Typhoon shelters and their peripheries.*
4. *Rear lanes, especially those associated with LPs and their surroundings.*
5. *Other rodent problematic spots*

Objectives of the Campaign are (1) to arouse public awareness on the significance of rodent control and prevention in the community; (2) to reinforce the message on prevention and control against rodents and their ectoparasites to people living/working in targeted biotopes and the peripheries; and (3) to reduce the rodent population and enhance rodent control in the territory, particularly in targeted biotopes and their peripheries. The Campaign slogan is “Prevent Disease Eliminate Rodent Nuisance” (“防鼠工作做得好 鼠患問題自然冇”)

Effective rodent disinfestations could never be achieved without concurrent treatment of all rodent-infested spots. Synchronized anti-rodent programmes by government pest control operators, private pest control practitioners and parties concerned are essential to the success of this Campaign. Should your members need any technical advice on rodent disinfestations, they could contact the Pest Control Advisory Section of our Department.

We trust our concerted effort in rodent disinfestations would lead to a better living environmental in Hong Kong.
